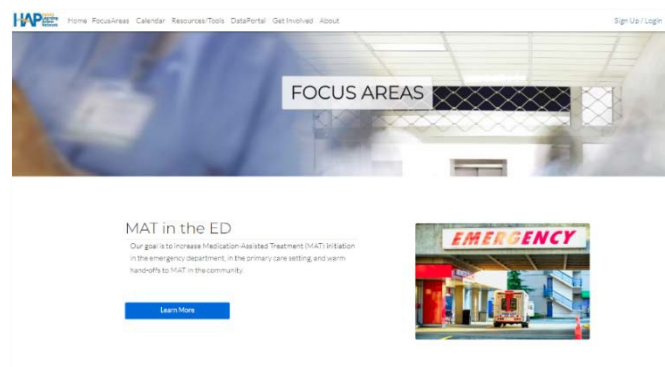
Below is a description of the various sections of the website.



Focus Areas

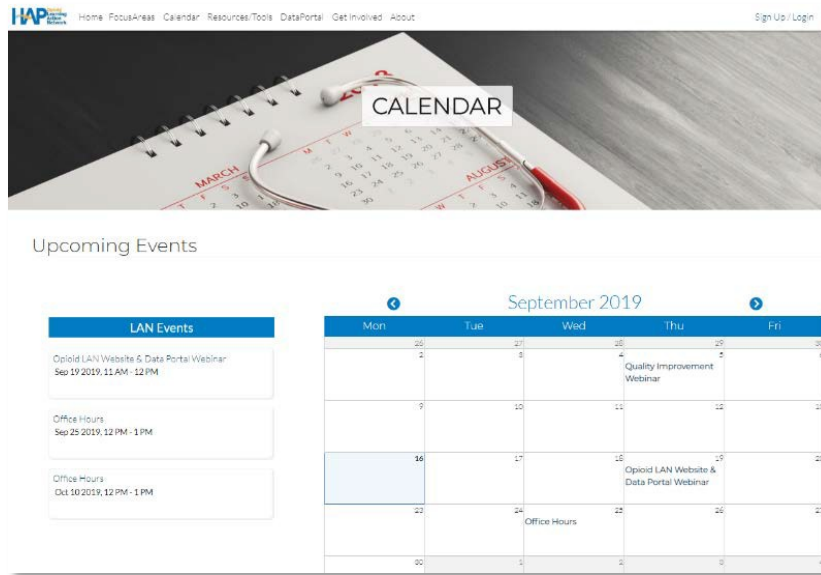
The focus areas of HAP's Opioid LAN centers around the adoption of four (4) pathways:

1. MAT in the ED: Increase medically assisted treatment (MAT) initiation in the emergency department, in the primary care setting, and warm hand-offs to MAT in the community
2. Warm Hand-off: Increase direct warm hand-offs to community providers for MAT or abstinence-based treatment, as well as, increased warm hand-offs in the primary care setting
3. Maternal OUD: Increase evidence-based Opioid Use Disorder (OUD) treatment and warm hand-offs for pregnant women through coordination with the PA Quality Collaborative
4. Direct Admissions: Increase the number of direct inpatient admissions for MAT initiation from the ED and of OUD patients hospitalized, overall

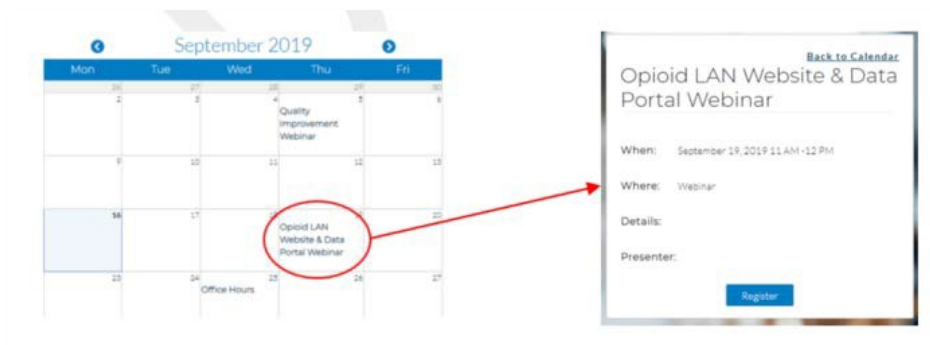


Calendar

Clicking on the event name will present you with more information regarding the event, including location, details, and links to the event registration.



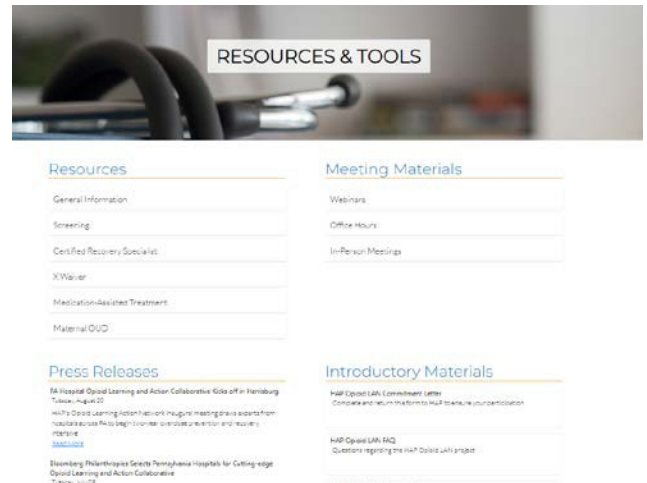
Data Portal

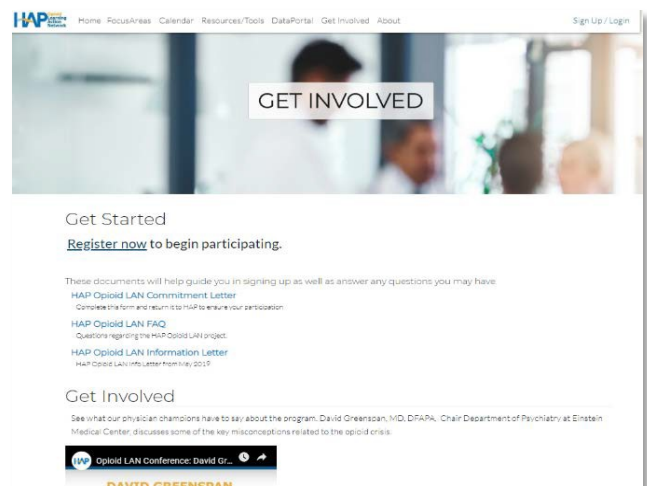
Resources/Tools

The Resources/Tools section has educational documents, online resources, meeting materials, presentations, LAN-related press releases, and other LAN material.



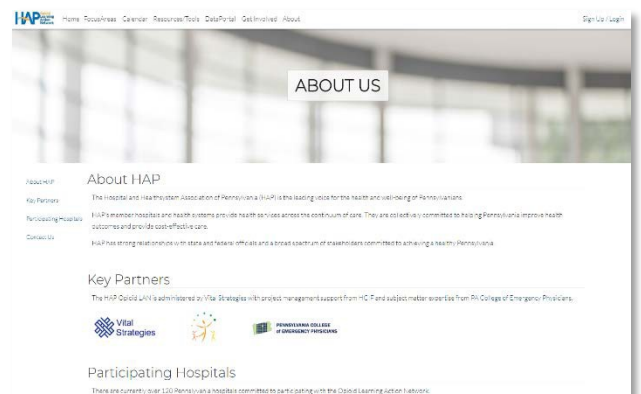




HAP Opioid LAN data portal

The HAP Opioid LAN data portal is accessible via the Data Portal section of the HAP Opioid LAN website. Only authorized users are able to access the data portal due to sensitive data. Users seeking authorization may submit a request at [HAP OLAN's data portal page](#).



Recovering your password

Recovering your user password can be initiated by clicking [Recover Password](#) on the data portal log in screen. Upon entering either your username or email address, an email will automatically be sent to you from donotreply@hapopioidlan.org. Users may have to check their junk/spam folders and validate the domain as acceptable to be received.




New account creation

Data Entry

Items listed in the Public tab are open for public consumption. Anyone with access to the data portal will be able to see these documents and scorecards. The following items will be part of the Public Tab:

1. HAP Opioid LAN Data Portal and website User Guide
2. Data dictionary
3. Appendix containing ICD 10 codes
4. List of participating hospitals

Header Descriptions

- Hospital
 - Name of the hospital or hospitals that a user has access to view
- Date
 - The month and year that can be viewed
- Status
 - Missing – Required data field(s) are missing
 - Pending – Required data field(s)
- Warnings
 - Shows the number of “warnings”. A warning is denoted when a required self-reported field is missing data
- Errors
 - Shows the number of “errors”. An error is denoted when required self-reported data does not pass the data validation parameters

Data Entry

Data entered into any data entry form will be saved automatically when the user performs **any** action that refreshes the screen, i.e., click any button at the top or bottom of the page or change a dropdown menu. If a user enters data into a form but closes the browser, data will not be saved.

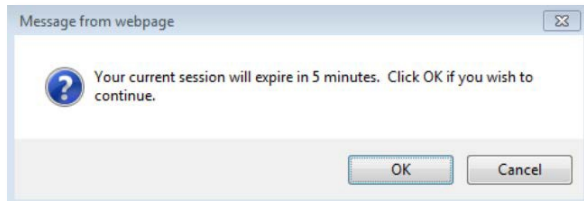

Popup Notifications

There are several pop up notifications that occur to notify a user.

- System Timeout: A security warning that appears after 15 minutes of user inactivity.
- The user will be automatically logged out upon 20 minutes of inactivity



- Data validation error: Appears when the system checks the entered data and finds an error.
 - Invalid entry (i.e. negative number)
 - Deleted existing data

Reports

The Reports tab is where users can generator real-time reports, meaning if a user enters data and runs a report immediately after, the recently entered data will be reflected in the report.

The reports tab presents several options.

- Focus
 - Name of the project – Opioid LAN
- Domain
 - Measures individualized for singular comparison
- Report Type
 - Ratio Grid Report
 - Ratio Grid Report w/ graph
- Series 1, 2, 3
 - User must select at least 1 series to report. Series 2 and 3 are optional if a user wishes to provide comparisons
- Start Date
 - Select starting month for report
- End Date
 - Select ending month for report
- Period
 - Months – Monthly reporting timeframe
 - Quarterly – Quarterly reporting timeframe
 - Years – Annual reporting timeframe

Measure Calculations

Factor: this field is not used for Measures 1 and 2 since they are numerators only. It is used for Measures 3-6 to calculate the percentages.

Denominator: this field is not used for Measures 1 and 2 since they are numerators only. It is used for Measures 3-6 to calculate the percentages. See below for the specific calculations of each measure.

Measure 1=	Numerator only
Measure 2=	Numerator only
Measures 3a=	Measure 3a / Measure 1
Measures 3b=	Measure 3b / Measure 2
Measure 4=	Measure 4 / (Measure 1 + Measure 2)
Measure 5=	Measure 5 / (Measure 1 + Measure 2)
Measure 6=	Measure 6 / (Measure 1 + Measure 2)
